OliveOilMedNet improves the olive oil sector by introducing innovative and effective ways through testing & validating relevant existing novel and ecofriendly concepts on the field of "sustainability" and "authenticity. To attain its' objective, it brings together Public Authorities, Producers' Associations and Research Institutions from 7 Mediterranean countries, adopting, further building and go beyond on the existing practices that have been already developed. OliveoilMedNet strengthens the capacity of the national/regional/local authorities engaged in the policymaking in the olive oil sector, and the capacity of olive oil companies to produce more competitive, "authentic" and "green" olive oil products.

 introduces of eco-friendly cultivation techniques, sustainable technology solutions in olive groves and olive oil mills, and the use of socio-economic and environmental evaluation tools and methodologies

 develops of an innovative network of stakeholders throughout the olive oil chain for the promotion of sustainable production and consumption practices to mitigate climate change impacts on the environment

### Successful organisation of the Kick-off Meeting of the project «OliveOilMedNet» in Preveza - Greece



The Kick-off Meeting of the project OliveOilMedNet with the title "Mediterranean Network for the Promotion of Sustainability and Authenticity in the Olive Oil Sector" was successfully organized by the Chamber of Preveza at its premises on 13 & 14 May 2024.

In the frame of the project, **Preveza Chamber leads** a partnership composed of public authorities, producer's associations and research institutions, from 7 Mediterranean countries. Specifically, the partnership is consisted of: **Chamber of Preveza**, **Hellenic Agricultural Organization "DIMITRA" - ELGO-DIMITRA**, the **Region of Peloponnese** from Greece, **Casa do Azeite - Portuguese Olive Oil Association** from Portugal, **CIA – Italian farmers – Regional Association of Puglia** and **Assoproli - Olive Producers' Association – Bari** from Italy, **Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Corsica** from France, **Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Paphos** from Cyprus, **University of Jaen** from Spain and **Agricultural University of Tirana** from Albania.

The meeting was attended by representatives from all project partners and of the associated partner **ETANAM** - Development Corporation of Southern Epirus - Amvrakikos – Local Government Development Organization. Also, the project officer, the financial and the communication officer from the **Joint Secretariat of the Interreg Euro-Med Programme** and representatives from **ISE Mission** participated actively.

During the first day of the Meeting, President of Preveza Chamber welcome all participants and afterwards the methodologies for the implementation of project's activities were presented by relevant partners. On the second day, management issues were discussed and decisions have taken concerning the next steps of the project. The meeting concluded with a study visit of project partners to local olive farms and olive mills.
